Preschool Autism Clinic

Reduced Cost Discrete Trial Training Services

Parents and professionals are able to receive instruction in an Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) technique called Discrete Trial Training (DTT), which is one of the few research supported interventions that teaches positive behaviors in children with autism.

The clinic provides parents and/or teachers with an overall assessment of their child's behaviors, which creates a web-based DTT program. Parents, teachers, and other support staff can access and use this program anytime via the internet. This will allow for parents to coordinate behavioral and IEP programming with the schools. Each family will receive two hours a week of clinic-based DTT and two hours a week at home. Parents and professionals will also be able to consult with licensed psychologists and other trained behavioral professionals throughout the year.

COST

\$2,000 for 12 weeks or \$6,000 for 40 weeks

Building Behaviors Autism Clinic 40 Week Program

Curriculum Assessment

Caregivers or professionals complete a skills checklist, which is used to create individualized ABA-based learning plans for the child. Over 1,200 lesson plans are divided into 8 categories: Pre-Academic, Academic, Social / Emotional, Daily Living, Motor Skills, Play & Leisure, Expressive Language and Receptive Language. Our staff will assist in the assessment process and help teachers and caregivers select the most appropriate lesson plans for the child. The curriculum meets common core state standards and is a great tool for creating and tracking IEP goals.

Preschool Clinic

Our staff is available on Tuesdays and Thursdays to provide 90-120 minutes weekly of DTT in a classroom setting at our clinic. Additional clinic sessions are available for an additional \$75 an hour.

Home and/or School Consultation

Our staff is available on Tuesdays and Thursdays to model or problem-solve any lessons with teachers, behavioral tutors, and caregivers. All programs come with weekly 90-120 minute home-based or school consultations. Additional consultative services are available for an additional \$75 an hour.

Video-Based Lessons

Step-by-step ABA-based video lessons break down complex concepts into short, easy-to-understand steps that teachers, parents, or other providers can implement immediately. General video lessons on ABA techniques and various webinars are also available.

Track Progress

Record results from teaching sessions, and have data automatically graphed for ongoing assessment. Easily manage data and generate automated progress reports online. Enhance collaboration and accountability by tracking performance across multiple staff and settings.
